

Third Frontier Internship Program allows Ohio companies to hire interns and receive reimbursement for half of the wages paid to the intern - up to \$3000 per year. The internships must be for one of the following categories: advanced manufacturing; advanced materials; bioscience; information technology; instruments, controls and electronics; or power and propulsion. Students must be an Ohio resident or student in an Ohio higher learning institution, have a GPA of 2.5 or above, and in a degree program for physical, biological, or agricultural sciences, or engineering, computer science, or math.

Steps to Participate in Third Frontier Internship Program

1. Go to <http://thirdfrontierintern.ohio.gov>, register your company, and post the internship(s) that you would like to have filled. Select “Greater Cleveland Partnership” as your partner for this project.
2. Have the student you would like to complete the internship register at <http://thirdfrontierintern.ohio.gov>.
3. Match the student to your available position (and have the student match to your organization).
4. The project administrator, Halley Marsh, will send you an email once the position is approved and the detailed instructions on how to submit invoices.
