APRIL IS 9-1-1 AWARENESS MONTH

The Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management is encouraging parents to teach children how to use 9-1-1 properly:

- 9-1-1 should be used for police, fire, and medical emergencies only.
- Know the location of the emergency. Providing an accurate address is critically important when making a wireless 9-1-1 call.
- If you call 9-1-1, don't hang up.
- Pay attention to the questions being asked when calling 9-1-1, and answer all questions. The more information they have, the better they are able to help you.
- Do not allow small children to play with a wireless/cell phone that is currently not in service because cell phone can still call 9-1-1. If you intend to give the phone to children for play, remove the battery.
