CLARIFICATION ON THE STORM WATER FEE

To manage the rainwater run-off throughout the City of Broadview Heights, a Stormwater Management Fee (SWM) was imposed per Ordinance 100-07 (later

amended by Ordinances 52-08 and 08-13). The fee began January 1, 2008 and will continue through December 31, 2016. The SWM monthly residential fee is \$4 payable and billed quarterly in arrears as part of the Broadview Heights Utility Billing.

The Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORS) also charges a SWM fee. NEORS's fee is separate from the City of Broadview Heights SWM fee. Any questions regarding NEORS's SWM fees should be directed to either of the following NEORS employees:
