SAFE DIGGING

Dominion East Ohio Gas has asked cities to remind residents of the importance of dialing 8-1-1 at least two working days prior to any digging, ditching, drilling, etc. Representatives of Dominion will then come to the location and designate nearby underground natural gas pipelines in the work area. Even minor contact with a pipeline (i.e., small dent, chip or scratch) can cause major damage, injury, and death if not professionally inspected and/or repaired as needed. Ironically, this safety threat is also the most preventable.
