## SNOW (PARKING) BAN

Ordinance 452-13 states that a snow emergency parking ban exists whenever, during any period of 24 hours or less, snow falls to a depth of two inches or more within the City, more particularly on any streets. No person shall park in the street for longer than three minutes for loading or unloading of passengers, or thirty minutes for loading or unloading of property or goods. Please use common sense when parking in the streets during the winter months to prevent your vehicle from being plowed in and allow the plows to clean the roads efficiently.
