  - **KINDERGYMNASTICS – Saturdays 9:00-9:30AM:** Children age 18 months through 4 years participate in a developmental floor gymnastics program with the emphasis on gross motor development. Participants will learn basic motor skills, acrobatics, physical fitness, flexibility, and coordination. These 30-minute classes meet once per week for five weeks. Class minimum 5; maximum 12.

## WHAT IS A MAYORAL PROCLAMATION

A Mayoral Proclamation is an announcement and/or acknowledgement of a special occasion, achievement, or cause. Information is provided to the Mayor’s office and the formal document is composed, printed, stamped with the Mayor’s seal, and signed by the Mayor. In some cases, the Mayor presents the document in person. In other cases, it is picked up or mailed, then presented and displayed by others. Some examples of situations when a proclamation is issued:

- Milestone birthday or anniversary for individuals or businesses
- A unique achievement (Olympic medal, State Championship, Eagle Scout, etc.)
- Support for a cause (Breast Cancer Awareness Month, Underage Drinking Prevention, etc.)
- Extreme good deed(s)
