## TALKING TRASH

- **PUT TRASH OUT NOT SOONER THAN ONE-HALF HOUR BEFORE SUNSET THE EVENING BEFORE COLLECTION**  
This is according to Ordinance 1060.02(b). Residents who put their trash out several days before their pick-up may be cited. Trash should also be at the curb by 7:00AM on your pick-up day – even if the truck doesn't usually come down the street until later in the day.
- **COMPACT FLUORESCENT BULBS (CFLs)**  
Those squiggly, energy-efficient lights contain mercury and should always be properly recycled. Retailers like Home Depot and Lowe's offer free recycling of CFLs. Simply take the expired, unbroken bulb to the store and place it in the proper recycling receptacle. County residents are encouraged to take advantage of these free retailer programs rather than spending public dollars to dispose of these bulbs through our Hazardous Waste Disposal Program.
- **HABITAT FOR HUMANITY/RE-STORE COLLECTION TRUCK COMING TO BROADVIEW CENTER - APRIL 5, 9AM-3PM**  
They are looking for contributions of materials and furniture to help in their mission of providing suitable housing in northern Ohio. They welcome donations of construction/rehab materials, sinks, toilets, kitchen cabinets, vanities, doors, garden tools and supplies, tools (hand/electrical/battery), appliances (refrigerators, washers/dryers, stoves, microwaves), freezers, counter tops, shingles, bricks, air conditioners, dressers, lamps, wood (6'-8' lengths), drywall, furniture, etc. Items should be usable and complete. No paint, bedding or clothing. Schedule a pick-up of larger items by calling 216-429-3631. Tax receipts are available. Donating these items keeps

them out of the landfill.

  - **KINDERGYMNASTICS – Saturdays 9:00-9:30AM:** Children age 18 months through 4 years participate in a developmental floor gymnastics program with the emphasis on gross motor development.
