- **BASKETBALL CAMP:** The Department of Parks and Recreation and the National Basketball Academy present the second annual Hoop Zone Basketball Clinic for boys and girls in grades 2 through 9. The focus of this 3-day program is to teach young athletes the fundamentals of basketball. Through a specialized program players will learn shooting techniques, point moves, passing skills with both hands, defensive principals, motion cuts, ball screen series, jab series, and more. Students are taught in a 10:1 ratio by professional instructors from The National Basketball Academy, a professional basketball training organization that offers skill training for individuals and teams through a variety of standard and custom training programs for professional, collegiate, high school, and young athletes.
