HYDRANT FLUSHING

The Fire Department will be flushing water mains and fire hydrants from approximately May 14 through June 15. This work will be done as part of the department’s ongoing preventative maintenance program. Generally, the work is performed between 9AM and 4PM, Monday through Friday. Signs will be posted

beforehand at the end of each street and at the entranceway to developments to make residents aware of the work being done.
