The Oaks of Brecksville will be screening for body mass index. Rehab Professionals will concentrate on flexibility. UH Parma Medical Center will offer blood pressure readings, stroke assessments, grip testing and depression screenings. Clear Choice will offer LASIK Eye Vision screenings (also bringing their Mr. iSee Truck and giving free ice cones outside). Akron General Hospital will do bone density screenings in the rear parking lot. Broadview Eye will screen for visual acuity, stereo acuity and color vision. ## OUR NATURAL GAS SUPPLIER IS CHANGING

Governmental Aggregation programs allow City officials to bring together citizens to gain group-buying power for the purchase of natural gas from a retail supplier licensed by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO). The City of Broadview Heights voters approved this program in 2002. Our contract with the current supplier is ending soon. We have chosen VESI, an Ohio based corporation, to provide you with natural gas on a yearly basis in consideration of rates offered. If you are NOT under contract with another supplier, you will automatically be enrolled – **UNLESS YOU TAKE ACTION TO “OPT OUT”**. You will receive a letter in the mail about this in the near future.
