SEX OFFENDER REVERSE LOOK-UP FEATURE

A new feature is now accessible through a database maintained by the Ohio Attorney General's Office. It allows anyone to put unfamiliar phone numbers, email addresses, social media screen names, and video game handles into the database to try to determine if they belong to a registered sex offender in Ohio. While it will not publicly identify the offender who registered the information, it will direct the individual to immediately contact the sheriff's office. The database can be accessed via the Attorney General's website.
