NEW GAS AGGREGATION SUPPLIER

Our contract with IGS Energy has expired and a new contract with VESI (Volunteer Energy Services, Inc.) was negotiated. Everyone that is not under contract with another supplier is included and the August bills will reflect the new supplier. As in the past, it is a variable rate which fluctuates up and down based on the market. The rate for usage in August will be \$4.158/mcf.

FEEDING WILDLIFE IS PROHIBITED

Just a reminder that Broadview Heights Ordinance 618.20 states that *...No person shall provide food for dogs, cats, deer, geese, ducks, raccoons, fowl or other wild animals or wildlife by setting such food out on any public property or within a 150-yard radius of any private residence or public roadway. This section does not apply to animals owned by the person or to songbirds fed from a stationary bird feeder...*
