- **LIFEGUARD CLASS:** New class instituted by the American Red Cross (Saturdays, Sept. 20-Oct. 18, 9AM-2PM). Lifeguarding, first aid, CPR. For the professional rescuer, AED and Preventative Disease Transmission will be covered. Must be 15 years by the END of class and pass a water test prior to class (anyone failing this test will receive a refund). No refunds

after the first day of class. Attendance at all classes is mandatory. Cost covers books and American Red Cross Fee.

- **NATIONAL BASKETBALL ACADEMY HOOP ZONE CLINIC:** Annual clinic for boys and girls in grades 2-9. The focus is to teach young athletes the fundamentals of basketball. Through a specialized program players will learn shooting, point moves, passing skills, defensive principals, motion cuts, ball screens and more. Students are taught in a 10:1 ratio by professional instructors. Clinic will be held in the Broadview Heights Gym Tuesdays, 9/16-10/21 for grades 2-5; and Thursdays, 9/18-10/23 for grades 6-9.
