- **Construction Update:** Construction is in full swing on the Ohio Caterpillar expansion, Bob Evans, Chipotle, and Danbury Woods Senior Housing.
- **University Hospitals:** The official Groundbreaking Ceremony for the new 52,000 sq.ft. medical facility was held this week. The project will include a 24 hour/365 day freestanding emergency department, outpatient laboratory services, physical therapy, and primary and specialty care

physician services. Services will be provided to meet an entire family's medical needs, including UH Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital pediatric services, women's health, orthopedics, pain management, general surgery, allergy and immunology, and cardiology.
