LEAF COLLECTION

Weather permitting, the crews will be doing a FINAL SWEEP of the entire city next week (December 1-5). Please be sure to rake your leaves this weekend as they will only come by once. All remaining leaves may be put in brown biodegradable bags and placed at the curb with the regular trash. *Reminder: Leaves should be raked to the tree lawn and NOT raked into the street! Also, keep leaves away from rocks, mailboxes, trees, and fire hydrants.*
