REMINDER:

- **A.A.R.P. TAX PREPARATION WILL BE AT BROADVIEW CENTER**
Appointments at this site will be on Tuesdays, February 3 through April 14 from 9:30AM to 3:00PM. Call 440-526-4685. Taxpayers must bring a photo I.D. (drivers’ license, state ID, etc.); Social Security documents for taxpayers and dependents; W-2s; 1099s; support for other types of income; support for deductible expenses (MUST be listed and summarized when presented to volunteer tax preparer); prior year tax return copies; and death certificate if filing for a decedent.

The most common “out-of-scope” matters (issues that make you ineligible for this free service) are: Schedule C (business profit and loss); Schedule D (capital gains and losses) without supporting paperwork; Schedule E (rental property) with expenses including depreciation; Schedule F (farm income); Schedules K-1 (involving depreciation or deductible expenses); Form 2106 (employee business expenses); Form 2210 (underpayment of estimated taxes by individuals, estates & trusts); Form 2439 (Notice to Shareholder of Undistributed Long-Term Capital Gains); Form 3903 (moving expenses); Form 4136 (credit for Federal tax paid on fuels); Form 8606 (non-deductible IRAs); Form 8615 (minors’ investment income); Form 8839 (qualified adoption expenses); Form 8885 (health coverage tax credit); Claim for Mortgage Interest Credits; Taxpayers who must file Form 1116; Returns (original or amended) further back than two prior years; Taxpayers affected by Additional Medicare Act (AGI > \$200,000, single; \$250,000 joint). **Note: There are many other “out-of-scope” issues that only occur occasionally and are too numerous to list.**
