- **AQUATIC EGG HUNT:** The Annual aquatic Easter egg hunt will be Friday, March 20. There will be floating eggs and sinking eggs for the hunters to find. One “magic” egg per age group will earn the hunter a special prize. Pre-registration by March 18 is REQUIRED.
- **SPRING SOCCER REGISTRATION** is ongoing now through February 28. Space is available in U6 Munchkins, U8 In-house Girls, U10 Girls Suburban, U12 Boys Suburban and U14 Boys Suburban. Waitlists exist in all other leagues.
- **WSI INFORMATION:** This course trains instructor candidates to teach all American Red Cross swimming and safety courses except Lifeguarding. Participants will be trained in a “hands on” structure of teaching.

Prerequisites: Must be 16 years old by the END of the class. Lifeguarding is NOT a prerequisite. All classes are mandatory – no exceptions. Cost covers books and the American Red Cross fee. Bring extra towels, bathing suit, writing utensils, highlighter and paper to each class. Call Amanda Lemp at 440-717-4026 for more information.

- **LIFEGUARD CLASS INFO:** This is the new lifeguard course instituted by the American Red Cross. Upon successful completion, participants receive the following certifications: Lifeguarding, First Aid, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Automatic External Defibrillator, and Preventative Disease Transmission. The National American Red Cross requires that participants be 15 years old by the END of the class. They must come in prior to class for a water test; anyone failing this test will receive a refund. All classes are mandatory – no exceptions. Cost covers books and American Red Cross fee. Bring lunch, extra towels, a bathing suit, writing utensils, highlighter and paper to each class. Class limit is 8. Call Aquatics Manager Amanda Lemp at 440-717-4026 for more information.
