## GARAGE SALE GUIDELINES – ‘TIS THE SEASON!

Per Ordinance 830.02, a permit is required for garage sales. The application can be [downloaded here](#). The fee is \$1.00. In summary:

- Sales may be no longer than three consecutive days.
- Sales shall be held ONLY between the hours of 9AM and 6PM.
- Only two signs per garage sale are permitted and should be 2 feet inside the property line.
- Sunday garage sales are not permitted.
- Garage sales are limited to two (2) per calendar year.
