FREE OUTDOOR ROCK CONCERT AND CRUISE-IN

Broadview Center Pavilion (near the football field)

The first of our three outdoor rock concerts (**Nights in the Heights**) will feature the band “*Everything Must Go*”, which is noted for its rock music from the 70s, 80s and 90s. There will also be a “Cruise-In” hosted by Next Level Auto Detailing with a specially-designated parking area for the vehicles. PROPOSED RECREATION CENTER ADDITION

The City Council is considering a proposal for a Recreation Center enhancement to be placed on the November ballot. This is based on results of a recreation survey taken last year. The proposal has been approved by the Recreation Committee and Parks & Recreation Board and is now being considered by Council. All meetings are open to the public.

Preliminary plans include an addition to the Community Building as well as renovations to the Human Services Department/Senior Center and other recreation areas. The addition would include two gymnasiums, an indoor track and a natatorium (zero-depth wading area with play features, activity space, lap lanes, water slides, a lazy river, sauna/steam rooms, and a whirlpool). Large doors would open out to a sun deck. The existing pool would be renovated into a new fitness center.

- **TRX:** Born in the Navy Seals, suspension training bodyweight exercise develops strength, balance, flexibility and core stability simultaneously. It requires the use of the TRX Suspension Trainer, a performance training tool that leverages gravity, and the users' body weight to complete hundreds of exercises. This 8-week course runs Thursdays (6:30-7:30PM) and/or Saturdays (8:50-9:50AM), June 11-August 8 (except July 2 & 4). Fees are \$89 for one class per week or \$169 for two classes per week.
