- **FREE OUTDOOR MOVIE AND CAMP OUT – SATURDAY, AUGUST 8**
Pre-Movie activities begin at 7PM. The movie “Big Hero 6 (PG)” begins at dark. Bring blankets and/or camp chairs and join us for a night under the stars! Concession stand will be open. Overnight campers must register in advance at the Recreation Center or online by Saturday, August 1. Registration for the campout is \$15 per family/tent. Campers can begin set-up of tents only after 5PM. A campfire and breakfast will be provided. Restrooms will be available all night. Minors must be accompanied by an adult. No alcoholic beverages permitted.

- **SUMMER CAMP** is going on now, 8:30AM-4:30PM weekdays. Pre-care and after-care are available. Includes games, movies, crafts, relays, game room, swimming, splash park and more. All field trips are included in the cost of camp for those signed up on the day of the field trip (space is limited on trip days).
