Rake leaves to the tree lawn before your scheduled week. Do not put them in the street! Leaves with grass and/or branches will not be picked up. (Note: If the crews finish an area ahead of schedule, they will jump ahead to the next area, but will return on the regularly scheduled day.) As an alternative, leaves may be put in biodegradable bags and placed with the regular trash.

- **FEEDING ANIMALS PROHIBITED**

Broadview Heights Ordinance 618.20(2) states, “No person shall provide food for dogs, cats, deer, geese, ducks, raccoons, fowl or other wild animals or wildlife by setting such food out on any public property or within a 150-yard radius of any private residence or public roadway. This section does not apply to animals owned by the person or to songbirds fed from a stationary bird feeder. Furthermore, (b) states that “Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense and a fourth degree misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense. Penalty shall be as provided in Section [202.99](#) of these Codified Ordinances.

- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** Please remember that Ordinance No. 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Signs are posted in various locations throughout the city.
