## REGIONAL PLAN FOR DEER POPULATION CONTROL: PUBLIC MEETING - MONDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 6PM AT BROADVIEW HEIGHTS CITY HALL

We have been collaborating with the cities of North Royalton, Parma, Parma Heights, Seven Hills and Strongsville to come up with unified legislation which, if adopted by respective Councils, will ask the voters on March 15, 2016 to

consider supporting a nuisance abatement initiative. This would permit limited hunting (the only legal method at this time) of white-tailed deer by crossbow or long bow by licensed individuals conducted from elevated platforms, under terms and conditions established by the State and City, and under the supervision of the respective police chiefs. Additionally, the communities will each appoint a representative to meet quarterly with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to explore, develop and implement long-term plans to safely and effectively manage the deer population, including non-lethal methods.

## LEAF COLLECTION CONTINUES

The crews will continue in AREA "C" as per the schedule that appeared in the October BroadView Journal. You can also [download the schedule here](#). Rake leaves to the tree lawn before your scheduled week. Do not put them in the street! Leaves with grass and/or branches will not be picked up. (Note: If the crews finish an area ahead of schedule, they will jump ahead to the next area, but will return on the regularly scheduled day.) As an alternative, leaves may be put in biodegradable bags and placed with the regular trash.

## IN CASE YOU MISSED IT...

- **FEEDING ANIMALS PROHIBITED**  
Broadview Heights Ordinance 618.20(2) states, *"No person shall provide food for dogs, cats, deer, geese, ducks, raccoons, fowl or other wild animals or wildlife by setting such food out on any public property or within a 150-yard radius of any private residence or public roadway. This section does not apply to animals owned by the person or to songbirds fed from a stationary bird feeder.* Furthermore, (b) states that *"Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense and a fourth degree misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense. Penalty shall be as provided in Section 202.99 of these Codified Ordinances.*
- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** Please remember that Ordinance No. 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Ordinance 452.20(a) requires that signs be posted at city limits.
