- **MEMORIAL DAY IN BROADVIEW HEIGHTS**
The City of Broadview Heights is holding its Memorial Day observance on Monday, May 30, 2016. A parade serves as the gathering ceremony for the memorial service which honors our fallen soldiers. It will step off from The Crossings Shopping Center at 11:00 AM on Broadview Road, just north of Route 82. Veterans, dignitaries, military families, sports teams, organizations, businesses, and classic cars are invited to participate. Contact Annette Phelps at 440-526-3651 for more information. Marching bands from Brecksville-Broadview Heights and North Royalton High Schools will be participating. Spectators are invited to join the end of the parade and follow it to the Broadview Center where there will be a memorial ceremony, veteran tribute, and complimentary refreshments. The Recreation Center open and free to residents from 10AM-4PM with adult open-swim from 10AM-noon and open swim for all ages from noon

to 3:30PM. The splash park will be open immediately following the Memorial Day Ceremony.

- **HYDRANT FLUSHING**

The Fire Department will be flushing water mains and fire hydrants from May 2- June 17, 2016. This work will be done as part of the Fire Department's ongoing preventative maintenance program. Generally, this work will be done during the hours of 9AM-3PM, Monday through Friday. Signs will be posted at the end of each street and at the entranceway to developments the day before flushing begins. We understand and appreciate your efforts in landscaping your property, but remember not to obstruct the hydrants with long grasses and/or shrubs. - **BOW HUNTING**

With the recent voter approval of changes to the hunting ordinance, we continue to work closely with surrounding communities to devise consistent rules and regulations relative to deer hunting, with safety being the highest priority. Until that time, hunting is not allowed.

- **NEW GUIDELINES FOR DISPOSING OF MATTRESSES AND UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE**

Our trash contractor, Rumpke, has advised us that mattresses, sofas and upholstered chairs should be wrapped in plastic before placing them at the curb. This practice is to insure the health and safety of the workers. You can use painters' plastic which is available in the paint department of any store. Call Rumpke 24 hours in advance of your pick-up day to advise them of the large items: 440-746-0678. **Other guidelines can be found on the back page of the Town Planner Calendar that all residents received in December.**

- **FEEDING ANIMALS PROHIBITED**

Broadview Heights Ordinance 618.20(2) states, *"No person shall provide food for dogs, cats, deer, geese, ducks, raccoons, fowl or other wild animals or wildlife by setting such food out on any public property or within a 150-yard radius of any private residence or public roadway. This section does not apply to animals owned by the person or to songbirds fed from a stationary bird feeder.* Furthermore, (b) states that *"Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense and a fourth degree misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense. Penalty shall be as provided in Section 202.99 of these Codified Ordinances.*

- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** Please remember that Ordinance No. 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Ordinance 452.20(a) requires that signs be posted at city limits.
