TREE RESPONSIBILITY

We have had many issues with dead Ash trees due to the Emerald Ash Borer. Ash trees become very brittle and hazardous after they die. If an ash tree is located where it might be hazardous to pedestrians, automobiles or houses, it should be removed. Residents often call with questions about removal of trees on their property, especially the tree lawn. While the tree lawn is in the city’s right-of-way, it does belong to the residents. Therefore, maintenance of trees in that area is the homeowners’ responsibility. The city will, however, assist if the tree falls into the roadway. - **SOLICITING IN BROADVIEW HEIGHTS**

There are several ordinances that pertain to soliciting in Broadview Heights. In summary:

 - Section 828.04 limits the hours from **10am-8pm**.
 - Section 828.05 states that, *"..no person engaged in business...shall call at any residence in the City which displays a NO-SOLICITATION sign.*
 - Section 828.06 reads: *"Peddlers and solicitors shall use only residential sidewalks and driveways.."*
 - Section 828.07 reads: *"..no person engaged in business...shall call upon...any residence...which is at that time on the "Peddlers/Solicitors Do Not Call Registry".*

Residents that do not want solicitors may put a **NO SOLICITING** sign in clear view on their door and [APPLY ON-LINE](#) to be listed on the Do Not Knock list which is available by following the links on the home page of our website. www.broadview-heights.org
- **BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR AND RESPONSIBLE CITIZEN**

- More people than ever are out walking in our neighborhoods. If you have a tree on your tree lawn, please trim low-hanging branches so that pedestrians and bicycle riders do not get hurt.
 - Do not put trash out prior to the night before your scheduled trash day. This is based on an ordinance.
 - Please clean up after your dog just as you would like others to clean up after theirs.
 - **FEEDING ANIMALS PROHIBITED**
Broadview Heights Ordinance 618.20(2) states, *“No person shall provide food for dogs, cats, deer, geese, ducks, raccoons, fowl or other wild animals or wildlife by setting such food out on any public property or within a 150-yard radius of any private residence or public roadway. This section does not apply to animals owned by the person or to songbirds fed from a stationary bird feeder.* Furthermore, (b) states that *“Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense and a fourth degree misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense. Penalty shall be as provided in Section [202.99](#) of these Codified Ordinances.*
 - **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** Please remember that Ordinance No. 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Ordinance 452.20(a) requires that signs be posted at city limits.
