- **VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE** is April 3, 2017 for the May 2, 2017 Primary Election. Voters who have moved or changed their name since they last voted need to complete and return a new Voter Registration Card on, or before this deadline. - **WEATHER SAFETY:** Ohio's Severe Weather Season is April 1-July 30. Visit <http://www.weathersafety.ohio.gov> to educate themselves and their families about what to do to prepare for a weather emergency.
- **AVERY ROAD BRIDGE CLOSED BEGINNING MARCH 13:** The Department of Public Works will replace Avery Road Bridge over Chippewa Creek. The road will be closed at the bridge. Avery Road will be open to local traffic only. Detour signs will be posted. The anticipated completion date is December, 2017. Funding is provided by Cuyahoga County Vehicle License Tax Fund and Federal Funding.
- **COMMUNITY SHRED DAY – APRIL 8:** The City is sponsoring its Annual Shred Day on Saturday, April 8, 9:00AM – 12:00PM. Residents can bring their private documents to be shredded on-site. Staples, fasteners and paper clips do NOT need to be removed. There is no charge, but all are asked to bring non-perishable (unexpired) food items or paper products for the Broadview Heights Food Bank. The limit is 5 boxes/bags per turn in line. Bring proof of Broadview Heights residency. No business shredding please.

- **UPDATE ON THE NEW COMMUNITY AND RECREATION CENTER**
ADDITION: The layout of the new Broadview Heights Community and Recreation Center has been finalized. We have now moved into the Design Development phase in which we are hosting meetings with Braun & Steidl Architects, Barker Rinker Seacat Architects, Water Technologies Inc., and Panzica Construction to further develop the plans for each space within the facility as well as the exterior of the building. - **E-COMMERCE SAFE SPOT:** The Broadview Heights Safe Spot will be located in the front parking lot near the pavilion on the Broadview Center property—an area that has surveillance cameras and is regularly traveled by the officers. There is a sign to mark the

spot. Registration is not required to use the Safe Spot. E-Commerce participants will be able to seal their deals in a safe environment.

- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** Please remember that Ordinance No. 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Ordinance 452.20(a) requires that signs be posted at city limits.
