HYDRANT FLUSHING BEGINS

The Fire Department will be flushing water mains and fire hydrants through June 10. This work is being done as part of the Fire Department's ongoing preventative maintenance program. Generally, the hydrants are flushed during the hours of 9AM-3PM, Monday through Friday. Signs will be posted at the end of each street and at the entranceway to developments the day before flushing begins. - Submission to, and acceptable results of pre-employment drug/alcohol test and criminal background check.

- **SWING AND JAZZ CONCERT:** This intergenerational concert is hosted by the Broadview Heights and Brecksville Human Services Departments and features the Cleveland TOPS Swingband and the BBH Middle School jazz band. It will be held Tues.,

May 9, at 7PM in the Brecksville-Broadview Heights High School Auditorium. The TOPS (Tough Old Pros) Swingband consists mostly of retired music professionals including music educators, area pit orchestra veterans and musicians with various band and orchestra backgrounds. They will be joined by the 6th, 7th, and 8th grade jazz band students for a fun evening of familiar music from days of old. The idea for this concert was conceived by Amy Washabaugh and Steve Paciorek, Directors of the Broadview Heights and Brecksville Human Services Centers, respectively. It is made possible through a grant from the Ohio Arts Council. The concert is free and open to the public.

- **SECOND ANNUAL COMMUNITY GARAGE SALE:** The City of Broadview Heights will be hosting a Community Garage Sale around the City on Saturday, June 10, 2017, starting at 9AM. Those who live in a neighborhood where the H.O.A. does not allow garage sales, or those that do not wish to have the sale at their home may reserve space at the Broadview Center parking lot from 9AM-2PM. The event will be held rain or shine. (Note: No three-day regular garage sale permits will be issued for that weekend.) The registration fee will cover:
 - Publicity in the local papers, website, electronic sign, the mayor's weekly email, Facebook, and signage.
 - A 20'x20' space in the parking lot for a vehicle and the display (participants must provide their own tables/tents)... or...the permit for those who hold the sale at their home.
 - Inclusion on a downloadable listing of garage sale addresses, plus a summary of sale items which will be posted on the city website and made available at the front desk.Register by Friday, June 2, on-line at www.bhrec.org or stop at the front desk of the Community Building. The cost to participate is \$10 for Rec Center Members; \$15 for Broadview Heights Residents.
Note: Residents who have an HOA in their neighborhood must follow the rules of the HOA.
- **MAY 2, 2017 – SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION:** Voter registration deadline is April 3. - **AVERY ROAD BRIDGE CLOSED BEGINNING MARCH 13:** The Department of Public Works will replace Avery Road Bridge over Chippewa Creek. The road will be closed at the bridge. Avery Road will be open to local traffic only. Detour signs will be posted. The anticipated completion date is December, 2017. Funding is provided by Cuyahoga County Vehicle License Tax Fund and Federal Funding.

- **UPDATE ON THE NEW COMMUNITY AND RECREATION CENTER**
ADDITION: The layout of the new Broadview Heights Community and Recreation Center has been finalized. We have now moved into the Design Development phase in which we are hosting meetings with Braun & Steidl Architects, Barker Rinker Seacat Architects, Water Technologies Inc., and Panzica Construction to further develop the plans for each space within the facility as well as the exterior of the building. - **E-COMMERCE SAFE SPOT:** The Broadview Heights Safe Spot will be located in the front parking lot near the pavilion on the Broadview Center property—an area that has surveillance cameras and is regularly traveled by the officers. There is a sign to mark the spot. Registration is not required to use the Safe Spot. E-Commerce participants will be able to seal their deals in a safe environment.
- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** Please remember that Ordinance No. 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Ordinance 452.20(a) requires that signs be posted at city limits.
