- **DEER MANAGEMENT:** The application packet for our Deer Control Program per Ordinance #32-16 is now available on the home page of our website. It contains detailed rules and regulations, property-owner agreement forms, target proficiency information, etc. [Click here](#) to view.
- **NORTH ROYALTON SCHOOLS NEED YOUR VOTE:** North Royalton City Schools and the North Royalton Educational Foundation are in the running for a \$25,000 grant from State Farm Neighborhood Assist to purchase adaptive bikes for the community. - **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** [Codified Ordinance](#) section 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3AM and 6AM. Per Codified Ordinance section 452.20 (a), signs are posted at city limits.
- **E-COMMERCE SAFE SPOT** is in the front parking lot near the pavilion on the Broadview Center property. It is an area that has surveillance cameras and is regularly traveled by the officers. There is a sign to mark the spot. Registration is not required to use the Safe Spot.
