NOVEMBER 7 GENERAL ELECTION

Local voters will elect candidates for judicial seats. There will also be ballot issues for all voters in Cuyahoga County including state, county, school and library issues. Broadview Heights voters will vote on an operating levy for the new recreation center. People who wish to cast ballots by mail need to obtain, complete, and return their Vote by Mail applications as soon as possible. To request an application visit: www.443vote.com, or call 216-443-VOTE (8683). Vote by Mail ballot applications are also available at all public libraries. The Board of Elections will begin mailing ballots to voters October 11. Early voting is available from October 11-November 6 at the Board of Elections located at 2925 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland. You may now register to vote online at www.443vote.com – deadline for the November 7 General Election is Tuesday, October 10, 9:00 PM. Voters who have not registered, have moved, or have changed their name must update or register to vote by the deadline. Registration cards are available at all public libraries and City Hall.

- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** [Codified Ordinance](#) section 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3AM and 6AM. Per Codified Ordinance section 452.20 (a), signs are posted at city limits.
- **E-COMMERCE SAFE SPOT** is in the front parking lot near the pavilion on the Broadview Center property. It is an area that has surveillance cameras and is regularly traveled by the officers. There is a sign to mark the spot. Registration is not required to use the Safe Spot.
