You can download the collection schedule [HERE](#), or view it in the October issue of the BroadView Journal. Area A consists of streets east of Avery, between W. Wallings & E. Royalton, excluding Summerwood (also includes the Valleepark Drive area). Leaves should be raked to the curb. DO NOT PUT IN THE STREET. Leaves with rocks, grass and branches will not be picked up. If the crews are ahead of schedule, they will move to the next area. However, they *will* return and start the route over as per the schedule. (Note that leaves can always be put in brown biodegradable bags and placed at the curb with the regular trash.)

- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** [Codified Ordinance](#) section 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3AM and 6AM. Per Codified Ordinance section 452.20 (a), signs are posted at city limits.
- **E-COMMERCE SAFE SPOT** is in the front parking lot near the pavilion on the Broadview Center property. It is an area that has surveillance cameras and is regularly traveled by the officers. There is a sign to mark the spot. Registration is not required to use the Safe Spot.
