

RESIDENTIAL ASSIST WITH RECENT STORM DAMAGE

Residents in the City of Broadview Heights experienced a severe storm on Sunday, November 5, 2017, resulting in excess foliage debris scattered among properties. To assist residents with this storm-related clean-up, the City of Broadview Heights will be providing additional debris pick-up in the form of a chipper service that will run from Wednesday, November 8, 2017 for one week.

Please place storm-related debris (i.e., branches) on your tree lawn for pick-up. Please be advised branches **MUST** be manageable in size to feed into the chipper and **in no case should exceed 6" in diameter**. Pick-up will occur city-wide in an orderly fashion, with pick-up starting at the hardest-hit areas and working outward.
