- **BE A VOLUNTEER FOR THE AARP FOUNDATION TAX AIDE PROGRAM:** AARP Foundation Tax Aide, the nation's largest free volunteer-run tax assistance and preparation service, is seeking volunteers to assist taxpayers in southwestern Cuyahoga County. Sites are in Broadview Heights, North Royalton, Parma (2), Strongsville, Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, and Brecksville. Volunteers do not have to be retired or a member of AARP. They are looking for leaders, tax return preparers, and greeters. All sites are electronic filing sites. Volunteers are expected to work at a site for at least 5 hours per week during the tax season. Each volunteer must have an email address; computer experience is preferred but not required. Previous income tax experience is not required. There is a free 2-week tax law and ethics course for leaders and tax return preparers in January. Greeters receive a free 1-day course on ethics and administration. - **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS:** [Codified Ordinance](#) section 452.05(c)(1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3AM and 6AM. Per Codified Ordinance section 452.20 (a), signs are posted at city limits.
- **E-COMMERCE SAFE SPOT** is in the front parking lot near the pavilion on the Broadview Center property. It is an area that has surveillance cameras and is regularly traveled by the officers. There is a sign to mark the spot. Registration is not required to use the Safe Spot.
