TREE LIGHTING AND HOLIDAY KICK-OFF PARTY

Tree Lighting in Broadview Heights is an extravaganza with fireworks followed by a huge family party. This year's event will be on Saturday, December 2nd at 6PM. The Spotlights' Costumed Carolers will serenade while everyone gathers for the 6:00 ceremony. Santa will arrive by fire truck to help light the trees. After the fireworks the party moves indoors where there will be Santa visits and free family photos, crafts, a dynamic DJ, a kids' carnival, inflatables, free refreshments and more until 8:30. There will be free use of the fitness center from 8AM-5PM, and open swim for ALL ages from 2PM-5PM. The event is free but everyone is encouraged to bring non-perishable (unexpired) food items for the food pantry and/or Yuletide Hunger Program.

LEAF COLLECTION CONTINUES

The season is drawing close to the end. As published, the final scheduled collection will be in Area C the week of 11/27/17. Following the completion of that area that week, one final sweep of the City will take place the week of 12/4/17. **All leaves should be on the tree lawn by Sunday, 12/3.** Any leaves accumulated after the truck passes through your neighborhood can be put in brown biodegradable (yard waste) bags and placed curbside for Rumpke to pick up on your regularly scheduled trash day. **Reminder: The truck cannot pick up leaves if there is a vehicle parked in front of the tree lawn.**
