TIPS FOR HOLIDAY RECYCLING

- **Energy-saving holiday lights** (LED) use 90 percent less energy than conventional holiday lights, and saves your family up to \$50 on energy bills during the holiday season.
- **BYOB (Bring Your Own Bag)** to reduce waste and free up your home recycling bin. Folded, re-usable bags also make great stocking stuffers and gift bags, too.
- **Drop off old cell phones and electronics** at AT&T, Best Buy, Staples, Verizon or other retailers that offer in-store recycling services.
- **Get out the old china dishes** and avoid using paper plates, plastic utensils, plastic cups and foil pans, none of which are recyclable. If you are packaging leftovers, reuse plastic containers or glass jars instead of throw-away alternatives.
- **Broken/tangled/burned-out holiday lights** can be brought to the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District for recycling. It is located at 4750 E. 131 Street in Garfield Heights. Hours are 8:30am-4:30pm.
