- **WRIGHT ROAD GAS MAIN REPLACEMENT:** This project will begin January 22 and consist of a new gas main between Sprague and Wallings. The project should not affect traffic; however, there may be instances where equipment is being mobilized and may require temporary one-lane traffic.
- **ALL GARBAGE IS TO BE PUT OUT BY 7AM:** Due to weather conditions, holidays, call-offs, etc. the normal pick up times will vary. Do NOT rely on the time that trash has been picked up in the past.
- **AUTOMATIC NOTIFICATIONS:** The City of Broadview Heights uses the Cuyahoga County notification system, ReadyNotify, to inform residents and businesses of local emergencies, non-emergency events and provide information about necessary actions.
