#### **COMMUNITY SHRED DAY – SATURDAY, APRIL 7, 9AM-12PM**

The City is sponsoring its Annual Shred Day at the Broadview Center, near the Service Garages. Residents can bring their private documents to be shredded on-site. Staples, fasteners and paper clips do NOT need to be removed. The shredding limit is 5 boxes/bags per turn in line. Bring proof of Broadview Heights residency. No business-shredding please!! There is no charge, but all are asked to bring non-perishable (unexpired) food items or paper products for the Broadview Heights Food Bank. Specific items needed include boxed potatoes, rice or rice mixes, canned meat, oatmeal, cereal/breakfast bars, nuts, shelf stable milk and milk substitutes, canned stews and canned fruit.

## **IN CASE YOU MISSED IT**

- **PROPOSED BUS TRIP:** Plans are being made for a two-day bus trip to Seneca Niagara Casino & Resort in June 2018. The package will include motor coach transportation; a one-night stay at the casino complex; gaming dollars and food voucher; Maid of the Mist ride; Adventure Theatre; a visit to the "Made in America Store"; lunch. - **HABITAT FOR HUMANITY COLLECTION – APRIL 14, 2018, 9AM-1PM:** Habitat for Humanity and its ReStore are looking for donations of clean/usable household furniture of all kinds, kitchen equipment and cabinets, tools, sinks, toilets, vanities, electrical supplies, lamps, ceramic tile, doors, appliances, hardware, etc. (NO paint, bedding or clothing.) If someone can use the item and it is in working condition, donate it to the ReStore to help its mission of providing suitable housing. - **FREE MEDICINE REVIEWS:** Participating pharmacies around the State will provide free, confidential medicine reviews for older adults who visit their locations. Pharmacy staff

will review customers' medicine usage and identify those medicines and combinations that may increase the risk for falls. Customers will receive a list of their potentially problem-medicines to take to their health care professionals so that they can discuss risks and appropriate treatment options. - **WRIGHT ROAD CONSTRUCTION:** Construction of Wright Road will begin Monday, March 26. The road will be open to traffic but delays should be expected.
- **MAY 8 PRIMARY ELECTION:** Ballot items include candidates for Governor, statewide offices, US Senate, US Congress, State House and Senate. The County Executive and some members of County Council as well as judicial candidates will also be on the ballot. This Partisan Primary Election is an opportunity for Democratic, Republican and Green party voters to select the candidates who will advance to the November General Election. - **TRASH COLLECTION REMINDERS:**
  - **ALL GARBAGE IS TO BE PUT OUT BY 7AM:** Due to weather conditions, holidays, call-offs, etc. the normal pick up times will vary. Do NOT rely on the time that trash has been picked up in the past.
  - **DISPOSAL OF PROPANE TANKS:** The Broadview Heights Hazardous Household Waste program will no longer accept standard propane tanks (20#) effective immediately. Blue Rhino propane locations now offer a free recycling program for 20# grill tanks. Anyone can recycle an unwanted grill tank by writing "RECYCLE" on the tank and taking it to a Blue Rhino location. Blue Rhino will accept any standard 20# grill tank, including non-Rhino brands. [More information](#) is available here.
  - **CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDELINES: Recycle these items:** Water/beverage bottles with caps on; beverage jugs (milk, juice, etc.) with caps on; food jars (mayonnaise, peanut butter, etc.) with caps on; plastic tubs and lids (yogurt, cottage cheese, etc.); laundry, shampoo and soap containers with caps on. **Do NOT recycle these items:** Fruit and lettuce containers (thermoform trays); produce, deli & bakery trays; plastic bags, wraps, film; cups (Solo cups, coffee cups); utensils and plates; fast food containers and cups, take-out containers (Styrofoam and molded plastic); bulky plastic (lawn chairs, crates, buckets, Little Tykes/Step 2 products); clothes hangers; toys, flower pots, straws, Styrofoam.
