COMMUNITY GARAGE SALE

The City of Broadview Heights will be hosting its third annual COMMUNITY GARAGE SALE around the City on Saturday, June 9, 2018, starting at 9AM. Those who live in a neighborhood where the H.O.A. does not allow garage sales, or those that do not wish to have the sale at their home may reserve space at the Broadview Center parking lot from 9AM-2PM. The event will be held rain or shine. **(Note: No three-day regular garage sale permits will be issued for that weekend.)** The registration fee will cover:

- Publicity in the local papers, website, electronic sign, the mayor's weekly email, Facebook, and signage.
- A 20'x20' space in the parking lot for a vehicle and the display (participants must provide their own tables/tents)... OR...the permit for those who hold the sale at their home.
- Inclusion on a downloadable listing of garage sale addresses, plus a summary of sale items which will be posted on the city website and made available at the front desk.

Register by Friday, June 1, on-line at www.bhrec.org or stop at the front desk of the Community Building. The cost to participate is \$10 for Rec Center Members; \$15 for Broadview Heights Residents.

FINANCE DEPARTMENT

In 2017 the State Legislature adopted HB 49 which included changes to Ohio Revised Code Section 718, which governs Municipal Income Taxes. The City is required to amend its Municipal Income Tax Ordinance to incorporate the changes. (These changes are related to net-profit tax filers and not residents who file an individual tax return.)

IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

- **RAIN BARREL WORKSHOP IN BROADVIEW HEIGHTS:** The Cuyahoga Soil & Water Conservation District will be holding a Rain Barrel Workshop at the Broadview Heights Recreation Center (Arts & Crafts Room) on **Tuesday, May 1, 6:30-8:00PM**. The Cost is \$60. The registration deadline is April 25. Rain barrels harvest rainwater for all your garden needs and combat stormwater pollution in the community. Each workshop participant will construct a 60-gallon rain barrel to take home. A barrel, downspout diverter and all materials are included. - **EAST MILL ROAD REPAIR:** East Mill Road **southbound** will be closed for repair starting the second week in April for approximately 3-4 weeks. There will be a detour via Lacey Lane to West Mill Road. Signage will be posted on the I-77 off ramp and on surrounding streets. Questions can be directed to City Engineer [Gary Yelenosky](#). - **PROPOSED BUS TRIP:** Plans are being made for a two-day bus trip to Seneca Niagara Casino & Resort in June 2018. The package will include motor coach transportation; a one-night stay at the casino complex; gaming dollars and food voucher; Maid of the Mist ride; Adventure Theatre; a visit to the “Made in America Store”; lunch. The cost will be approximately \$199-\$214 per person for double-occupancy. The trip will be booked if enough people are interested. Please call 440-526-4685 to let us know you will be coming. (Note: A passport will not be needed as we will be staying in the United States.)
- **MAY 8 PRIMARY ELECTION:** Ballot items include candidates for Governor, statewide offices, US Senate, US Congress, State House and Senate. The County Executive and some members of County Council as well as judicial candidates will also be on the ballot. This Partisan Primary Election is an opportunity for Democratic, Republican and Green party voters to select the candidates who will advance to the November General Election. However, all voters including nonpartisans will have an opportunity to decide State, County, school and municipal issues.
- **TRASH COLLECTION REMINDERS:**
 - **ALL GARBAGE IS TO BE PUT OUT BY 7AM:** Due to weather conditions, holidays, call-offs, etc. the normal pick up times will vary. Do NOT rely on the time that trash has been picked up in the past.
 - **DISPOSAL OF PROPANE TANKS:** The Broadview Heights Hazardous Household Waste program will no longer accept standard propane tanks (20#) effective immediately. Blue Rhino propane locations now offer a free recycling program for 20# grill tanks. Anyone can recycle an unwanted grill tank by writing “RECYCLE” on the tank and taking it to a Blue Rhino location. Blue Rhino will accept any standard 20# grill tank, including non-Rhino brands. [More information](#) is available here.
 - **CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDELINES: Recycle these items:** Water/beverage bottles with caps on; beverage jugs (milk, juice, etc.) with caps on; food jars (mayonnaise, peanut butter, etc.) with caps on; plastic tubs and lids (yogurt, cottage cheese, etc.); laundry, shampoo and soap containers with caps on. **Do NOT recycle these items:** Fruit and lettuce containers (thermoform trays); produce, deli & bakery trays; plastic bags, wraps, film; cups (Solo cups, coffee cups); utensils and plates; fast food containers and cups, take-out containers (Styrofoam and molded plastic); bulky plastic (lawn chairs, crates, buckets, Little Tykes/Step 2 products); clothes hangers; toys, flower pots, straws, Styrofoam.
