IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

- **WIDENING OF BROADVIEW & OAKES INTERSECTION:** The City of Broadview Heights has received Federal Funding for the **“Improvement of the Broadview Road and Oakes Road Intersection”**. The project will improve traffic capacity and reduce traffic congestion. The project limits are from 225 feet south of Oakes Road to 262 feet north of Oakes Road and proposes the construction of a left turn lane on Broadview Road and

an upgrade of the signal at the intersection. During construction, traffic on Broadview Road and Oakes Road will be maintained as well as access to all properties. The City is requesting input from residents. - **BABY DEER – ABANDONED OR NOT?** It is important for everyone to realize that deer do not abandon their young. Fawns, like many other wild animal babies, are frequently hidden and left alone for hours by their mothers while they forage for food. For the first couple of weeks, these babies generally nap while waiting for their mothers to return. They lay very still so as not to attract predators (like well-intentioned human animals), and are frequently mistaken for being in distress or abandoned. If roaming about, they may appear to be weak and stumbling, and actually are newly born. Their mothers are usually within visual range, and can always hear if their baby cries out. - **PLANNING A BLOCK PARTY?** Please [send an email to the Mayor's office](#) with details of your event (date, time, location, etc.) so that we can notify the safety forces of the gathering. Reminder: Do not put tables, chairs, grills, games, etc. in the street. The emergency vehicles must have access.
- **ORDINANCES RELATIVE TO FOOD TRUCKS:** With the growing popularity of food trucks, and with the safety of the public in mind, the Broadview Heights City Council passed Ordinance #1650.08 *Permitting and Regulation of Mobile Food Trucks*. In summary, **ALL food trucks must obtain a permit from the Broadview Heights Fire Department.** For use on city property, vendors must also obtain approval from the Broadview Heights Building Department. - **TRIMMING OF TREE LAWN TREES:** Please help us be a “walkable” community by pruning the trees on your tree lawn. The Shade Tree Commission recommends a minimum height of 6’6”. This will help keep our pedestrians and bike-riders safe.
- **ALL GARBAGE IS TO BE PUT OUT BY 7AM:** Due to weather conditions, holidays, call-offs, etc. the normal pick up times will vary. Do NOT rely on the time that trash has been picked up in the past.
- **CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDELINES: Recycle these items:** Water/beverage bottles with caps on; beverage jugs (milk, juice, etc.) with caps on; food jars (mayonnaise, peanut butter, etc.) with caps on; plastic tubs and lids (yogurt, cottage cheese, etc.); laundry, shampoo and soap containers with caps on. **Do NOT recycle these items:** Fruit and lettuce containers (thermoform trays); produce, deli & bakery trays; plastic bags, wraps, film; cups (Solo cups, coffee cups); utensils and plates; fast food containers and cups, take-out containers (Styrofoam and molded plastic); bulky plastic (lawn chairs, crates, buckets, Little Tykes/Step 2 products); clothes hangers; toys, flower pots, straws, Styrofoam.
