#### NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GELERAL ELECTION

There are federal, state, county and judicial candidates on the ballot, as well as state and local issues. In addition, there are proposed Charter changed for the City of Broadview Heights. The Board of Elections advises people to be prepared to vote by taking a few simple steps: Check their registration status and make sure they are registered at their current address; then select their voting method. Voter Registration deadline is 9PM Tuesday, October 9. Registration is now available online at <a href="http://www.443vote.com">http://www.443vote.com</a>, at Broadview Heights City Hall, or at all public libraries. Early voting is October 10-November 5 at the Board of Elections located at 2925 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland (hours are posted on the Board's website.) Voters may also submit vote by mail ballot applications if they wish to vote from home. To request an application visit: www.443vote.com, or call 216-443-VOTE (8683). Vote by Mail ballot applications are also available at all public libraries. To vote in-person, bring identification and consider confirming your polling location online. The polls are open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. (NOTE: The Board is seeking thousands of poll workers to assist voters on Election Day. Poll workers are paid up to \$200.00 and may apply online or by calling the Election Officials Department at 216-443-3277.)

## \*CITY RULES & REGULATIONS\*

- NOISE ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO OUTDOOR EQUIPMENT: No person shall use engine
  or motor- powered garden, lawn or maintenance tools intended for repetitive use in
  landscaping in residential areas, typically capable of being used by homeowners,
  including garden tools, riding tractors, walking tractors and power mowers, between the
  hours of 8:00 p.m. of any day and 8:00 a.m. of the following day
- MINORS CURFEW: Per <u>Chapter 648.10</u> of the Broadview Heights Code of Ordinances the curfew age & hours are as follows:

Age	Hours
Through 12	.Darkness to 6:30 a.m.
13 through 15	10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
16 through 17	11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday;

16 through 17.....Midnight to 6:00 a.m., Friday and Saturday Please refer to Chapter 648.10 for complete details.

- ORDINANCES RELATIVE TO FOOD TRUCKS: With the growing popularity of food trucks, and with the safety of the public in mind, the Broadview Heights City Council passed Ordinance #1650.08 <u>Permitting and Regulation of Mobile Food Trucks</u>. In summary, ALL food trucks must obtain a permit from the Broadview Heights Fire Department. For use on city property, vendors must also obtain approval from the Broadview Heights Building Department. For more detailed information, <u>click here</u>.
- TRIMMING OF TREE LAWN TREES: Please help us be a "walkable" community by pruning the trees on your tree lawn. The Shade Tree Commission recommends a minimum height of 6'6". This will help keep our pedestrians and bike-riders safe.
- ALL GARBAGE IS TO BE PUT OUT BY 7AM: Due to weather conditions, holidays, call-offs, etc. the normal pick up times will vary. Do NOT rely on the time that trash has been picked up in the past.
- CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDELINES: Recycle these items: Water/beverage bottles with caps on; beverage jugs (milk, juice, etc.) with caps on; food jars (mayonnaise, peanut butter, etc.) with caps on; plastic tubs and lids (yogurt, cottage cheese, etc.); laundry, shampoo and soap containers with caps on. Do NOT recycle these items: Fruit and lettuce containers (thermoform trays); produce, deli & bakery trays; plastic bags, wraps, film; cups (Solo cups, coffee cups); utensils and plates; fast food containers and cups, take-out containers (Styrofoam and molded plastic); bulky plastic (lawn chairs, crates, buckets, Little Tykes/Step 2 products); clothes hangers; toys, flower pots, straws, Styrofoam. - NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS: <u>Codified Ordinance</u> section 452.05(c) (1) prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 3AM and 6AM. Per Codified Ordinance section 452.20 (a), signs are posted at city limits.
