## **FAQ's (FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS)**

### ***How do I recycle in Broadview Heights?***

Recyclables are picked upon the same day as the regular collection (the same truck comes by twice.) You can co-mingle your glass/plastic/metal cans, bottles and jars in the same blue bag. Place the blue bag(s) at the curb, separate from the regular trash. (Newspapers should be in their own bag.) Apartment dwellers may participate by putting their blue bags on the curb of the main road on the regular trash day for that road. Remember: Trash and recyclables should be put at the curb by 7AM.
