Reminder: ROUTE 82 IN BRECKSVILLE TO BE CLOSED

State Route 82 between Old Royalton Road and Highland Drive will be closed to traffic in both directions between July 29 and August 12, as mandated by the Ohio Department of Transportation. The closing is required for the replacement of a drainage culvert, a slope repair and some minor pavement repairs. During this closure, the detour route will be along Old Royalton Road which runs parallel to Route 82. It is suggested that alternate routes be taken since the detour is through a residential neighborhood.
