F.A.Q.'s (FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS)

How do I dispose of paint?

- **Oil-based paint/stain** can be dropped off at the Broadview Heights Service Garage (off Oakes Road) any workday (Mon.-Fri.) between 7AM and 3PM (NO LATEX PAINT).
- **Latex paint** should be dried out. When it is no longer liquid, put it in the regular trash bag. There are several ways to dry out paint: (1) leave the lid off for however long it takes; (2) mix with kitty litter, sawdust, or a drying-product sold in paint departments; (3) pour into a box lined with foil; repeat when the layer is dry.
