F.A.Q.’s (FREQUENTY ASKED QUESTIONS)

Is there a place to take documents to be shredded?

There are two locked boxes in city hall where residents can take a small bag of private papers. One is on the first floor in the Human Services Department and one is in the Mayor’s office. The boxes have a slot where you can put your papers in – a handful at a time. Every eight weeks the shredding truck comes and shreds the contents of the two boxes. If you have more than a shopping bag of papers, you can take them to the Valley View office of Shred-It (our contractor) on certain Saturday mornings. They will charge a reduced rate per box (since we have a contract with them). Call them directly at 1-800-69SHRED for more information. *(Note that we are planning to host a “Shred Day” this summer. Stay tuned.)*
