- Tax filings and payments may be deferred until July 15th. The Treasury Department will not be applying any interest of penalty on amounts normally due with the 2019 return up to \$1 million for individuals (including those who are self-employed) and up to \$10 million for corporations. - For bar and restaurant owners who have large reserves stocked up in alcohol inventory, the state of Ohio is offering a one-time liquor buy-back to return unopened, high proof liquor products purchased from February 13th to March 15th 2020.
