- GoToMeeting/LogMeIn has created a [free service](#) for healthcare, educational, non-profit and government organizations to host meetings, video conferencing, etc. for three months
- Webex also offers [a free no-commitment platform](#) for virtual meetings
- Google Hangouts also has a [free offering](#) until July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 for companies not covered by GoToMeeting
- [Microsoft Teams](#) is a unified communication and collaboration platform that combines persistent workplace chat, video meetings, file storage and application integration. It is an add-on app package that connects with your Microsoft Office Suite. Microsoft is offering free subscriptions for several months if you currently have a license with them.
