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- A. **The permit holder is responsible for scheduling all inspections.**
 - B. If the homeowner obtains the permit on behalf of a contractor, you are liable for all work including any violations or any uncompleted work.
 - C. General contractors and subcontractors must be registered with the Building Department and are required to be bonded, insured and registered with R.I.T.A.
 - D. As the permit holder you are responsible to obtain the necessary approval of all the Committees, Boards or Associations that may have restrictions on the work covered by this permit and assume full responsibility for any lack of approval.
 - E. The permit holder shall be responsible to immediately notify the Building Department as to any changes to the approved permit (i.e. plans, contractor or subcontractors).
 - F. For purpose of reviewing, approving or disapproving this application and or request the applicant hereby agrees, consents and grants right of entry to the above described premises to the necessary and appropriate City representatives.
 - G. Use of unregistered or unlicensed contractors or subcontractor are cause for refusal or revocation of this application and permit and may result in work stoppage, court citations or both.
 - H. **I know the location of my property lines. The accessory structures will be placed on my property, maintaining the appropriate setbacks and side yards.**

Instructions and Additional Information

The application and form must be typed or clearly written in blue or black ink. If an application is submitted and is not complete or missing information it can delay processing of the application.

Exterior Work:

A lot drawing of your property **MUST be provided** and specifies the following:

1. Size of the lot and distance between property pins
2. Location of house, garage, sheds, decks and other major structures
3. Location of accessory structures on the property.
4. Locations of swales, drain pipes/tiles, catch basins.
5. Sufficient drawings must be submitted with the application showing the location of the pool, equipment, accessory structures, patio, drainage etc.

Payment Methods:

Fees can be paid by cash, check or credit card (3.5% service charge a \$0.50 minimum charge).

Inspections:

A 24-hour inspection notice is required prior to the time when inspection need to be performed. Please call 440-526-6864 between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00pm to schedule an inspection. **A final inspection is required for all permits.**

§ 1448.09 All construction requiring and authorized by a building permit **shall be fully completed**, inspected and certified as being in conformance with all applicable provisions of the Building and Housing Code **within 12 months of the date of the issuance of the building permit.**

***Fences**

1. Show total linear footage
2. Show locations of the gates, height of fence, style of fence, type/material of fence
3. Show/label if the house on a corner lot

Temporary /Seasonal Pools

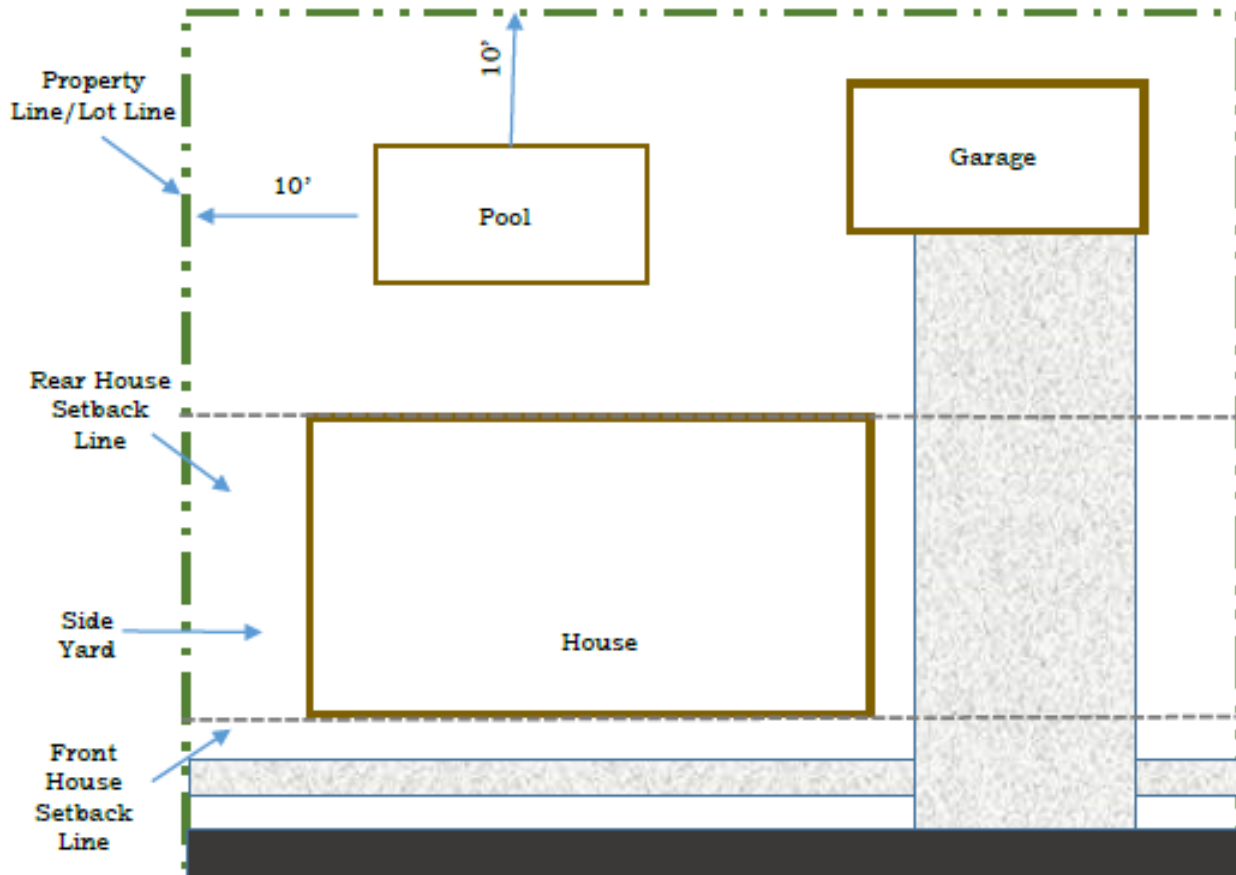
Any temporary seasonal above-ground pool (for example: inflated, rigid metal sides with metal supports, plastic sides with plastic supports, "baggy" soft-sided, etc.)

Temporary swimming pools are only permitted from start of the swimming season to the end (May-September). Temporary pools shall meet all pool requirements. Temporary pools shall be removed after the month of September of each year and stored in a completely enclosed structure.

GUIDELINES

10' from the side yard and rear property lines

- No private permanent pool shall be constructed or any alteration, addition, remodeling or other improvement made there to, without first obtaining a permit
- No private portable pool shall be placed upon any premises or moved upon any premises, or moved from place to place, without first obtaining a permit.
- As part of the application you must show the location, size, depth, plans and specifications thereof of the pool, the site development and such other information as may be required.
- No swimming pool or swimming pool deck shall be located, constructed or placed at any side yard of a corner lot that abuts the street
- Required: copper bonding conductor 4" to 6" deep 18" to 24" from the pool edge to circle the entire pool and connected to the motor ground. Must bond all metal pool parts to the copper bonding ring
- Hard wired pump requires a switch within sight of the motor. Twist lock receptacle mounted on weather proof box with cover on a 4" x 4" post must be between 6' to 10' of pool. Gfi outlet mounted in a weather proof box with cover, within 20' from edge of pool.
- No pool can't be closer than ten feet to any side or rear property line of any parcel
- No pool can't be located, constructed or placed in any front yard.
- All overflow or drainage from a pool shall be contained on the property on which the pool is located.
- Each pool and/or spa shall be completely surrounded by a fence not less than 48 inches above grade.
 - It doesn't apply to a pool entirely above the ground if the sides of the pool are at least 48 inches above finished ground level.
- All gates or doors opening into such enclosure shall be designed to permit locking
- No swimming pool or spa cover in any form or type of construction shall be considered a qualifying barrier or substitute for a fence barrier.
- An electrical and/or a plumbing permit is required – Installation by licensed electrician and plumber.
- Temporary swimming pools are only permitted from start of the swimming season to the end (May-September). Temporary pools shall meet all pool requirements. Temporary/ seasonal/ portable pools shall be removed after the month of September of each year and stored in a completely enclosed structure.
