INTRODUCED BY MAYOR AND ENTIRE COUNCIL

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO
DISPOSE OF CERTAIN ITEMS NO LONGER NEEDED
BY WAY OF INTERNET AUCTIONS,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Broadview Heights intends to dispose of items that are no longer needed for Municipal purposes via Internet Auctions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. The City is hereby authorized to dispose of items that are no longer needed for Municipal purposes via Internet Auctions.

SECTION 2. Such auctions shall be conducted by listing the items(s) for a minimum period of ten (10) days to be sold to the highest bidder at the expiration of the ten day period in an "as is" condition.

SECTION 3. The city shall use www.govdeals.com [1-800-613-0156] or www.ebay.com as its representative for such Internet Auctions.



This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare and for the further reason stated in the Preamble hereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) or more of the members of council and the signature of the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
